The Australian Government, as part of the commitment to deliver savings by abolishing the Carbon Tax, announced its intention to discontinue funding for the Clean Technology Program. This includes the three program components: the Clean Technology Investment Program, the Clean Technology Food and Foundries Investment Program, and the Clean Technology Innovation Program (Media

Release: [Our Plan to get the Budget under Control, 28 August 2013](#)). The Programs are now closed to new applications. AusIndustry has contacted all applicants directly with advice on the status of their application.

Description

The Clean Technology Innovation Program is a competitive, merit-based grants program that will support applied research and development, proof of concept and early stage

commercialisation activities that lead to the development of new clean technologies and associated services including low emission and energy efficient solutions, that reduce greenhouse gas emissions. The program will provide grants between \$50,000 and \$5 million on a co-investment basis of one dollar of government funding for each one dollar of the applicant's investment.
