ELECTRICITY SUPPLY ACT 1990 ELECTRICITY SUPPLY (COMPOUNDING OF OFFENCES) REGULATIONS 2001

IN exercise of the powers conferred by subsection 43(2) of the Electricity Supply Act 1990 [Act 447], the Minister makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as The Electricity Supply (Compounding of Offences) Regulations 2001.
- (2) These Regulations come into operation on 2 January 2002.

Compoundable offences

- All offences specified in subsection 43(1) of the Act may be compounded.
- (1) An offer to compound shall be made in Form 1 of the Schedule.
(2) A person who accepts an offer to compound shall furnish payment for the compound by using Form 2 of the Schedule
(3) Upon payment of the compound, an official receipt for the payment shall be issued to the person to whom the offer of compound was made.

Revocation

- The Electricity Supply (Compounding of Offences) Rules 1994 [P.U. (A) 320/1994] is revoked.
